A Gospel Reflection:

In today's Gospel, Mark tells us the story of the time Jesus healed Bartimaeus, "who was blind." Not only was he unable to see, but he was also impoverished. Out of his two-fold need, he cries out to Jesus: "Son of David, have mercy upon me!" Can I identify with this blind beggar? Do I have a physical limitation out of which I cry out to God for mercy? Do I have a deeper longing from which I shout out for mercy? Do I even bring this to Jesus?

That Bartimaeus shouts out for mercy when he hears that Jesus of Nazareth is about to pass by is a sign that the mercy of God is already at work. How often is it that we first rely upon ourselves in our need? We know the grace of God is with us when our hearts prompt us to shout out to Jesus in our need. Too often, though, we ignore this prompting, and we rely upon our own capabilities to fix ourselves or our situations rather than shouting out to Jesus for mercy.

Jesus longs for more. Mark depicts Bartimaeus crying out for mercy twice! Not only should we cry out once, but twice for mercy; and not just twice, but again and again. Not only does Bartimaeus cry out for mercy twice, but he is "sternly ordered to be quiet." He endures in his prayer for mercy, and we should too! In our prayers, we should never grown faint or weary. We must endure in prayer, because as his children, He wants a reciprocal relationship with us. We receive His Love, and we give Him ours.
